

DOMINICAN IMPACT

With partners in Consuelo, La Romana and Santo Domingo.

20+ Dominican community health workers

200+ Dominican pediatric residents trained in state-of-the-art primary care of children under 5

3,000 children under 5 covered in Ninos
Primeros en Salud

- Early initiation of breastfeeding from below 20% in 2009 to 83% in 2021
- Decreased child severe malnutrition rate from 10% in 2009 to under 2% in 2022
- Biannual deworming program: now >80% of eligible children received two doses of albendazole each year







BOTSWANA IMPACT

With partners including the Ministry of Health and University of Botswana, CHOP and Penn.

400+ doctors trained at Botswana's first medical school

\$10 million received in research and public health funding to advance child health and evidence-based practice.

150+ peer-reviewed papers many of which have informed both Botswana's national and global guidelines (e.g. through the WHO and others in HIV, TB, immunizations)



GLOBAL HEALTH IN BOTSWANA: GLOBAL HEALTH NURSING FELLOWSHIP

- Established through a partnership with CHOP Nursing, the Botswana-UPenn Partnership, the University of Botswana and Princess Marina Hospital
- CHOP neonatal nurses complete 3month rotations at Princess Marina Hospital in Botswana
- 1st Fellow, Molly, is currently in Botswana and has been busy with:
 - Orientation for new cohort of NNU Nurses
 - Facilitation of a resuscitation workshop
 - Drafting report of her observations for Nurse Manager


